

## Academic Term Codes

Each term (semester) is assigned a four-digit code to identify it in UAConnect. Some terms will contain multiple sessions, such as Intersessions and Eight Week sessions. The table below describes how to decipher and interpret this code.

Character	Represents	Value	Description
1 <sup>st</sup> character	The century of the term	0 = 20 <sup>th</sup> century 1 = 21 <sup>st</sup> century	0 = Term enrollment through 1999 1 = Term enrollment from 2000
2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> character	The year of the term	99 = 1999 16 = 2016 17 = 2017 18 = 2018	The academic year begins with the Fall term. Use this for the term code. <i>Example: 2018 = 18</i>
4 <sup>th</sup> character	The actual term	<b>Regular Terms</b> Fall = 9 Spring = 3 Summer = 6  <b>Independent Study</b> Fall = 8 Spring = 2 Summer = 5	<b>Regular terms</b> are the major academic terms and may contain additional sessions within the term. Intersessions are found in the regular terms.  <b>Independent Study</b> terms allow grades, GPAs, and requisites to be met in advance of the Regular term.
Century=21 <sup>st</sup> , term year = 2017, term = Fall 9 (regular term)
