This quick reference guide (QRG) supports students in setting up a payment plan.


SIGN UP FOR A PAYMENT PLAN

- 1. From the Workday Home page, click the **Global Navigation**Menu in the top left corner of your screen.
- 2. Click Financials Hub within the 'Menu.'

3. View the amount 'Due Now' and click **Make a Payment**.



4. Notice that you will be redirected outside of the Workday application to complete the payment.

By continuing, you'll be redirected outside of the Workday application.

5. Click OK.

6. Type in your institutional **User Name** and **Password** credentials.



7. Click the **Sign In** button.



8. Below 'Payment plans,' click **Set up auto pay**.

9. View the payment details, including the date of the 'First scheduled payment' and 'Payment amount.'



Note that additional payments will be made on payment plan due dates.

10. Read the 'Auto pay terms and conditions.'


11. Check the **I Agree** box to indicate that you agree to the payment terms and conditions.



12. Click Continue.

13. Select the **Payment method** or type in **New credit or debit** card or **New bank account** information.



14. Click Continue.

15. Check the **acknowledgement** box to indicate that you accept the terms and conditions of the Transact user agreement.



16. Click Continue.

- **17.** Review the information and verify that the 'Auto pay details' are accurate.
 - (Optional) Click **Change** to update the payment method, if needed.

18. Click Complete.

- 19. Click the Go to overview button.
- **20.** Notice that below 'Summary,' you can now see the next auto-payment date and amount.
